WMA or WEA	AREA SPECIFIC STIPULATIONS
Baird Unit of Richloam	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Buck Lake-----	A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dirt roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. Permit valid only during periods open to hunting.
Bull Creek	No additional stipulations. Permit valid only during periods open to hunting. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.
Caravelle Ranch	Permit valid only during periods open to hunting.
Dexter Mary Farms Unit of Lake George	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.5. No ATV use in active timber harvest areas.6. No ATV use in active prescribed burn units.7. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Dunns Creek

A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dim roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.

Emeralda Marsh SGA

Permit is valid for upland/levee travel only. A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dim roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.

Etoniah Creek

1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.
2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.
4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.
5. ATVs are prohibited on the designated fireline off of South Cablegate Road, the Florida Trail, and other designated hiking trails (map included with permit).
6. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Fort Drum

Permit is valid for upland/levee travel only. A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dim roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.

Ft. McCoy	ATVs are prohibited in and around active timber harvesting operations. Please note: The assistant allowed in item 10 of this permit must be either another RUP holder, for this WMA, or his or her dependent child 16 years of age or younger; or spouse, if not hunting. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Gore's Landing Unit of Ocklawaha	No additional stipulations.
Guana River	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee must use existing firelanes and trails. 4. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Half Moon	Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Jumper Creek	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible. 4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas. 5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Kilbee Unit of Little Big Econ	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible. 4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas. 5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Lake George	A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dim roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. ATVs are permitted on named and numbered roads for access from perimeter parking areas. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Lake Monroe	AMP permit is not valid on this area.

Lake Panasoffkee

1. A fluorescent orange flag shall be attached to the ATV on an eight-foot mast.
2. ATV must have operable headlight, brake light and taillight if used during dawn and dusk hours.
3. Permittee shall specify upon entry through the check station what area(s) of the WMA the permittee intends to access with the ATV.
4. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
5. ATVs shall only be operated on existing roads and firelanes, which are not currently named or numbered on the WMA hunt brochure map. Cross-county travel is prohibited.
6. ATVs are prohibited in wetlands, streams, rivers, areas posted as closed to hunting, restoration areas or other areas restricted for land management activities. ATVs shall not be operated within nor parked on any road, trail or firelane adjacent to an active prescribed burn unit. Restricted areas will be posted at the check station.
7. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas when campground equipment is permitted.
8. Permits will only be valid during periods when the WMA is open for hunting and one day prior to each hunt from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., except prior to small game hunts.

Lake Tracy Unit of Seminole Forest

1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.
2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.
4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.
5. Permit valid only during periods open for scouting and hunting.

Marshall Swamp

AMP permit is not valid on this area.

Matanzas	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible. 4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas. 5. No ATV use in active timber harvest areas. 6. No ATV use in active prescribed burn units. 7. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Ocala	AMP permit is not valid on this area per US Forest Service policy.
Orange Creek SGA	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A photocopy of the AMP shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 2. Permittee must utilize existing dirt roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible, prior to crosscountry travel. 3. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations. 4. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.
Prairie Lakes Unit of Three Lakes	No additional stipulations.
Relay	ATVs are prohibited in and around active timber harvesting operations. Please note: The assistant allowed in item 10 of this permit must be either another RUP holder, for this WMA, or his or her dependent child 16 years of age or younger; or spouse, if not hunting. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Richloam	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible. 4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas. 5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Rima Ridge Unit of Tiger Bay

1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.
2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.
4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.
5. No ATV use in active timber harvest areas.
6. No ATV use in active prescribed burn units.
7. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Rock Springs Run

ATVs may be operated only on named or numbered roads, firelines and service roads.

Ross Prairie

1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.
2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.
4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.
5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Salt Lake

Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.

Seminole Forest

ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. A copy of the AMP will be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. The use of established pathways is recommended, to the greatest extent possible. ATVs are permitted on named and numbered roads for access from perimeter parking areas. Permit valid only during periods open for scouting and hunting.

Seminole Ranch

1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting.
2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV.
3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible.
4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas.
5. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting. For those qualified as AMP, contact SJRWMD for a Special-Use Authorization to access the area after the hunting season: (386) 329-4410.

Three Lakes	No additional stipulations.
Tiger Bay	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. ATVs are prohibited in areas posted as closed to hunting. 2. A copy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. 3. Permittee should use established pathways to the maximum extent possible. 4. ATV use is prohibited in campground areas. ATVs transported by a vehicle displaying an AMP permit on the dash are permitted in campground areas. 5. No ATV use in active timber harvest areas. 6. No ATV use in active prescribed burn units. 7. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Tosohatchee	Service roads are gated and locked; contact the FWC area biologist at 407-568-5893 at least one week in advance to coordinate opening of needed service roads.
Triple N Ranch	Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Twelve Mile Swamp	ATVs are prohibited in and around active timber harvesting operations. Permit valid only during periods open for hunting.
Upper St. Johns River Marsh	<p>Permit valid only in the Moccasin Island walk-in area and only within the area denoted on the Upper St. Johns AMP map as “Alternative Mobility Permit Area.” The southern boundary of the Alternative Mobility Permit Area was mapped using the Four-mile Canal and Wickham Road. Permit is valid for upland/levee travel only. A photocopy of the AMP permit shall be displayed on the dash of the vehicle used to transport the ATV. Permittee must utilize existing dim roads, trails, or firelanes to the maximum extent possible prior to cross-country travel. ATVs are not permitted in or around active timber harvesting operations.
