RULE TITLES: Wildlife Violator Compact
Definitions.

RULE NOS.:
68A-1.007

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of this rule development effort is to effectuate the Wildlife Violators Compact suspensions.

SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: Subject areas covered in the proposed rule include the wildlife violator compact suspensions/revocations of hunting and fishing privileges from other states the Commission will honor.

SPECIFIC AUTHORITY: 372.8311 Florida Statutes

LAW IMPLEMENTED: July 1, 2006, 372.8311 Florida Statutes, Compact licensing and enforcement authority; administrative review.-- (1) LICENSING AND ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY.--For purposes of this act and the interstate wildlife violator compact, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission is the licensing authority for the State of Florida and shall enforce the interstate Wildlife Violators Compact and shall do all things within the commission's jurisdiction which are necessary to effectuate the purposes and the intent of the compact. The commission may execute a resolution of ratification to formalize the State of Florida's entry into the compact. Upon adoption of the Wildlife Violators Compact, the commission may adopt rules to administer the provisions of the compact.
