Instructions for Completing Applications

Biographical Data

Complete **all information** in this section. The information must pertain to the person (possessor/owner) applying to possess the wildlife. The facility address, including the county, should be the physical location where the wildlife is to be housed or possessed. If the facility address is a rural route, please provide directions to the location on a **separate** page.

Inventory

Check the appropriate box(es), indicating whether you currently possess or plan to possess the **species and Class** of wildlife for which you are applying. The list of designated Class I and Class II wildlife species can be found on the inventory page of the application.

NOTE: Only those specimens of Class I wildlife possessed and licensed for personal use on **August 1, 1980** shall be eligible for a personal use license. **No other Class I wildlife shall be kept for personal use.**

Zoning Statement and Documentation of Experience

Zoning:

Attach statement stating that the construction of the facility, its cages and enclosures, is not prohibited by county ordinance and if within a municipality, any municipal ordinance. **This statement must be submitted with all initial applications and for all facility relocations.**

Documentation of Experience:

Attach documentation of experience. Documentation of such experience shall include a description of the specific experience acquired, dates and times experience was obtained and the specific location(s) where acquired. Include two letters of reference from individuals having personal knowledge of your stated experience.

CLASS I: Applicants shall demonstrate no less than one (1) year of substantial practical experience (to consist of no less than 1, 000 hours) in the care, feeding, handling and husbandry of the species for which the permit is sought, or other species, within the same biological order (except ratites) which are substantially similar in size, characteristics, care and nutritional requirements to the species for which the permit is sought.

CLASS II: – Applicants shall demonstrate no less than one (1) year of substantial practical experience (to consist of no less than 1, 000 hours) as described above, **or** demonstrate 100 hours of substantial practical experience and successfully complete a written examination (80%) which is administered by the Division of Law Enforcement. Application should not be submitted until notification by FWC that you have completed the exam.

Inventory Page

Provide a complete inventory of the species of wildlife for which you are applying to possess. On the inventory page of the application, indicate only the number of specimens in each category, which you currently possess.

Critical Incident/Disaster Plan:

Failure to complete the application will result in application being returned and/or denied.
