

## WILDLIFE ATTRACTANT SCORECARD

<u>Are trash containers accessible to wildlife?</u>	Yes = 0, No = 1
<u>Is there an odor present?</u>	Yes = 0, No = 1
<u>Are garbage receptacles always stored inside?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>If inside, in a garage for example, are the doors kept secured?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>If garbage is stored outside, is it in a secure building?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Are the receptacles covered with strong, locking lids?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Is garbage placed for pick-up the morning of service?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0

<u>Is feeder hung from a cable approximately 20' from the ground?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Is spilled food picked up nightly?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Is compost pile outdoors?</u>	Yes = 0, No = 1
<u>Is compost pile distant from the house, woods or other cover?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Does compost include household waste, food scraps, etc.?</u>	Yes = 0, No = 1
<u>Is compost strictly lawn clippings?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Ripe fruit and vegetables present:</u>	Yes = 0, No = 1
<u>Are gardens, berry patches and orchards electric fenced?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
<u>Beehives or livestock secured with electric fencing?</u>	Yes = 1, No = 0
