



Application Instructions and Official Rules for **WINGS OVER FLORIDA**

The “Wings Over Florida” program awards full color certificates at five achievement levels to bird watchers who report their life lists to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. This program is a free service to residents and non-residents.

Application Instructions

1. Clearly mark off each species you have identified by sight or sound in Florida (your life list of Florida’s birds). If using the “Checklist of Florida’s Birds” booklet (2002), mark your sightings using column “A”. Count the total number of birds marked on your checklist ***excluding exotic (nonnative) birds***. These introduced species can pose a threat to the survival of native Florida bird populations. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission strongly discourages the introduction of exotics into the state. Examples of exotics include:

Muscovy Duck	Budgerigar	Red-whiskered Bulbul	House Finch
Rock Dove	Monk Parakeet	Black-hooded Parakeet	House Sparrow
Eurasian Collared-Dove	Spot-breasted Oriole	White-winged Parakeet	European Starling

2. Fill out the application sheet on the back of this page. **Only one applicant per application sheet.** Be sure to list the total number of birds you have witnessed in Florida excluding exotic species and circle the certification level for which you are applying.

Five Certificates Of Achievement:

I.	Cardinal Level (Beginner):	50-149 birds recorded on your Florida Checklist
II.	Scrub Jay Level (Intermediate):	150-249 birds recorded on your Florida Checklist
III.	Skimmer Level (Advanced):	250-299 birds recorded on your Florida Checklist
IV.	Egret Level (Veteran):	300-349 birds recorded on your Florida Checklist
V.	Kite Level (Elite):	350+ birds recorded on your Florida Checklist

No exotic species (established or non-established) can be counted.

All birds listed must be alive, wild, and unrestrained when observed.

All birds listed must be identified by sight or sound by the person submitting the application.

Only one individual may be listed on each certificate awarded.
