SPL A Saltwater Products License (SPL) and a commercial vessel registration is required to harvest over the recreational bag limit or when harvesting more than 100 pounds or 2 fish per person per day (whichever is greater) for species that do not have an established bag limit. Certain gear may also require a SPL.
Please check current regulations and any additional permit/license requirements of the Federal Permitting Office (727) 570-5326.

D E F I N I T I O N S	Saltwater Product		Any species of the saltwater fish, marine plant of echinoderm, except shells, and salted, cured, canned or smoked seafood.
	Saltwater Fish		Shall include all classes of Pisces, shellfish, sponges and crustacean indigenous to saltwater.
	Species Designated As Restricted		Required to exceed the recreational bag limit and/or to sell species designated as a Restricted Species. Species currently designated Restricted: African Pompano, Amberjack, Black Drum, Black (Striped) Mullet, Bluefish, Blue Crab, Clams (Brevard County only), Crawfish/Lobster, Cobia, Florida Pompano, Flounder, Grouper, Hogfish, King Mackerel, Permit, Red Porgy, Cobia, Sea Bass, Sheepshead, Shrimp, Snapper, Spanish Mackerel, Spotted Sea Trout, Stone Crab, Triggerfish, Tripletail, and Tropical Marine Fish and Plants including ornamental sponges. Additional species may be designated as Restricted at any given time, as a result of Commission ruling.

DOCUMENTATION	<input type="checkbox"/> Photocopies of Commission approved Trip Ticket Records generated under a valid Saltwater Products License, documenting qualifying sales of saltwater products to a licensed wholesale dealer. If tickets do not total at least \$5,000, see 25% of annual income provision. Trip tickets should be embossed and submitted showing a dollar value to avoid delay in processing. DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL TRIP TICKETS.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Copies of sales records from locations other than Florida documenting qualifying sales of saltwater products. A copy of the out of state license from the applicable state must also be submitted with the Restricted Species Application.
	<input type="checkbox"/> A complete copy of the applicable Federal Income Tax Return , including <i>IRS Form 1099</i> attachments, verifying income earned from the sale of saltwater products. If you file a joint return, provide all attachments necessary to separate your spouse's/dependent's income. Applicants must show sales of fishing proceeds. May be used only with Charter Boat Operation or 25% of Annual Income Qualifying Method.
	<input type="checkbox"/> A crewshare statement verifying income earned from the sale of saltwater products. <i>Dates of harvest must be specified on statement and cannot exceed a 12-month period. (Month and year must be specified.)</i>
	<input type="checkbox"/> A Certified Public Accountant's (CPA) notarized statement attesting to qualifying source and amount of income. Sales must be under a valid SPL to a licensed Wholesale Dealer. The Wholesale Dealer name and license number must be specified, as well as, the sales per dealer and date of sales. CPA must read this form prior to completing a statement.

EXEMPTIONS	A	Permanent age 62 or older - A permanent Restricted Species endorsement shall be available to those persons age 62 and older who have qualified for such endorsement for at least 3 out of the last 5 years.
	B	Active military duty time shall be excluded from consideration of time necessary to qualify and shall not be counted against the applicant for purposes of qualifying.
	C	Upon the sale of a used commercial fishing vessel , owned by a person, firm or corporation possessing or eligible for a Restricted Species endorsement, the purchaser of such vessel shall be exempted from the qualifying income requirement. This exemption is for a period of one (1) year after purchase of the vessel. Copy of original title showing purchase price and copy of vessel registration showing use as Commercial at the time of sale must be submitted as qualifying documentation.
	D	Upon the death or permanent disablement of a person possessing a Restricted Species endorsement , an immediate family member wishing to carry on the fishing operation shall be exempt from the qualifying income requirement for the purpose of obtaining a Restricted Species endorsement for a period of one (1) year after the death or disablement. A copy of birth certificate and proof of death or disablement are required.
	E	Persons Age 62 Years or Older - A Restricted Species endorsement may be issued on an individual SPL to a person age 62 or older who documents that at least \$2,500 is attributable to the sale of saltwater products.
	F	Permanent/ Persons Age 70 Years or Older – A permanent Restricted Species endorsement may also be issued on an individual SPL to a person age 70 or older who has held a Saltwater Products License for at least 3 of the 5 license years.
	G	Disability exemptions for Florida Residents. Any resident who is certified to be totally and permanently disabled by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor, or by any branch of the United States Armed Forces, or who holds a valid identification card issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs pursuant to s. 295.17, upon proof of the same, or any resident certified to be totally disabled by the United States Social Security Administration, upon proof of the same, shall be exempted from the income requirements if he or she also has held a saltwater products license for at least 3 of the last 5 license years prior to the date of the disability. A Disability Award Notice issued by the United States Social Security Administration is not sufficient certification for a resident to obtain the income exemption unless the notice certifies that the resident is totally disabled. This exemption may only be issued on an individual SPL.
