

2016 Lionfish Challenge Raffle: Official Rules

1. This contest is being conducted by the Fish & Wildlife Foundation of Florida, Inc, a 501c3 Corporation located at 2574 Seagate Drive Suite 100 Tallahassee, FL 32301.
2. Winners of the raffle drawing are eligible to receive one of a number of prizes including:
 - \$100 gift card for dive tank refills (10 available)
 - Neritic polespear with three-prong tip (10 available)
 - Zookeeper Lionfish Containment Unit (5 available)
 - Annual saltwater license with lobster permit (2 available)
 - \$200 fuel card (2 available)
 - Sportsman Gold License (2 available)
3. Current employees of Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for or win any of the Lionfish Challenge raffle prizes.
4. Must be 18 years of age or older to enter
5. There is no cost to enter to win. To be eligible to win the participant must submit a photo of their first 50 lionfish harvested in Florida waters to Lionfish@MyFWC.com.
6. Additional entries are made by bringing in lionfish tails to any of the FWC approved lionfish checkpoints. For every additional 50 lionfish submitted, participants will receive one additional raffle entry.
7. Winners of the Sportsman Gold License or Annual Saltwater License with Lobster Permit must abide by all applicable Florida fishing laws and regulations.
8. Winners will be randomly drawn, on the following dates at 10AM: June 7, 2016 (3 winners); June 20, 2016 (4 winners); July 5, 2016 (4 winners); July 18, 2016 (4 winners); August 1, 2016 (4 winners); August 15, 2016 (3 winners); August 29, 2016 (3 winners); September 12, 2016 (3 winners); September 26, 2016 (3 winners). Drawings will be made at the office of the Fish & Wildlife Foundation of Florida, Inc., using a computer program designed for random selection. The winner will have ten (10) business days after notification to accept/claim their prize. Otherwise it will be offered to the next alternate selected in the drawing.
