- a. Contraceptive implant administered 11/97 to prevent further reproduction.
- b. 3 back cross kittens (2M, 1F) handled at den 10/2/98, evidence seems to indicate kittens didn't survive.
- c. TX 102 was road killed on CR833, Hendry County, 9/31/95. Upon necropsy, 3 half term fetuses were found in her uterus.
- d. Died 8/19/99 due to metabolic complications from pregnancy. Was carrying 4 close to term (1-2 wks.)
