TRIP 4 – Caesar Creek 6-mile round-trip

Easy round-trip paddle on beautiful meandering creek--good seasonal wildflower viewing and birding opportunities.

Start and end at Gardner Landing. Drive 12 miles north from Hwy. 98 on S.R. 65. Turn left off S.R. 65 on Gardner Landing Road and go 2.7 miles to the boat ramp.

Navigation

From boat ramp paddle northwest (right) and go about 0.3 miles to the entrance of Caesar Creek on right (GPS = N 29° 49' 18" / W -84° 59' 32"). You will be able to paddle upstream about 3 miles before creek narrows, depending on water levels and deadfall trees. Return to Gardner Landing.

GPS:

A. = N 29° 49' 02" / W -84° 59' 14"

B. = N 29° 49' 18" / W -84° 59' 32"

TRIP 5 – Gardner Landing to Fanny Lake 6-7 miles

Easy round-trip paddle to secluded small, cypress-ringed pond.

Start and end at Gardner Landing. Travel 12 miles north from Hwy. 98 on S.R. 65. Turn left on Gardner Landing Road and follow signs 2.7 miles to boat ramp.

Navigation

As you leave the boat ramp head south (left) around a small island, and bear south (left) to East River. The East River Cutoff will enter from your right at about 0.8 miles. Turn right (west) and proceed about 1.5 miles to the entrance of Fanny Lake. It will be on your right, watch for paddling sign (GPS = N 29° 48' 37" / W -85° 00' 10"). You will be able to paddle about a mile round trip depending on water levels. Return to East River Cutoff, and proceed to the left, back to the East River. Bear north (left) and go 0.8 miles back to Gardner Landing.

A. = N 29° 49' 02" / W -84° 59' 14"

B. = N 29° 49' 18" / W -84° 59' 32"

C. = N 29° 48' 37" / W -85° 00' 10"
