
**Eastpoint Fire: Extension of 2017-2018
License Year for Commercial Saltwater
Licenses and Endorsements for Franklin
County.**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraphs 17 and 22, hereby implements special measures to provide regulatory relief to licensed commercial harvesters and dealers located in Franklin County who may have been affected by the Eastpoint fire in June 2018.

In order to assist commercial harvesters and dealers return to business as soon as possible, effective immediately, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission implements the following regulatory relief for commercial harvesters and dealers who reside in or have a business located in Franklin County, Florida.

1. All commercial saltwater licenses, including but not limited to wholesale dealer, retail dealer and saltwater products licenses, and all endorsements currently in effect for the 2017-2018 license year are extended past the June 30, 2018 renewal date and shall remain effective until July 31, 2018. The license renewal deadline shall be extended from June 30, 2018 to July 31, 2018.
2. By this order, the Commission directs wholesale and retail dealers and all law enforcement officers to recognize the extension of the license year.
3. All other provisions governing all commercial saltwater licenses and endorsements remain in effect.
4. This order shall take effect immediately upon signature and shall remain in effect until July 31, 2018.
