**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 18-48-A1**  
**TROPICAL STORM MICHAEL**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida (Commission), acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under the Delegations of Authority, February 14, 2013, pursuant to Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, hereby adopts the Executive Office of the Governor, Executive Order No. 18-276 (Emergency Management – Tropical Storm Michael), Section 4(B). Pursuant to the Governor’s Executive Order No. 18-276, the Commission is suspending the provisions of any regulatory statute prescribing the procedures for conduct of state business or the orders or rules of the Commission, if strict compliance with the provisions of any such statute, order, or rule would in any way prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency.

This Order shall be retroactive to Sunday, October 7, 2018, the date of the Governor’s Executive Order No. 18-276. This order shall expire upon the date of the Executive Order No. 18-276 or the date of amended Governor’s Executive Order if so issued.

Specific Authority: Executive Order No. 18-276 of the Executive Office of the Governor and Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution.
