


2018-2019 WILD TURKEY COST-SHARE PROJECTS

Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, Florida Forest Service and Florida State Chapter – National Wild Turkey Federation



The sites indicated on the map below are wild turkey management projects to be conducted through a cooperative funding program between the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC), the Florida Forest Service (FFS) and the Florida State Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation (FCNWTf). Funding for this program is provided in part through the purchase of Turkey Permits by hunters (FWC funds) and dollars provided by the FCNWTf from their Super Fund program (which includes revenue generated from Hunting Heritage banquets and other fund raising events). Funding for this cooperative program totaled \$491,213 for the 2018-2019 project period and included 37 projects on 29 managed properties (e.g., Wildlife Management Areas, National Wildlife Refuges) and three regional focal areas. When considering the additional \$1,761,966 of cooperator and in-kind funding provided for these projects, the total program value for the 2018-2019 project period is \$2,253,178. Site numbers on the map below correspond to the location, project description, cost-share funding, and cooperator funding on the included table.
