Executive Order Number: EO 18-56

**Operation Outdoor Freedom General Gun  
Hunt on Twin Rivers Wildlife Management  
Area – Blue Springs Unit**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of Florida Constitution, and Rule 68A-15.004(16), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), hereby authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service (FFS) consistent with section 589.19(4), Florida Statutes on the Twin Rivers Wildlife Management Area – Blue Springs Unit in Hamilton County, Florida.

**OPEN SEASON**

Special general gun hunt: December 3-6, 2018.

**LEGAL TO TAKE**

Deer with at least 1 antler having 3 or more points (each point 1-inch or more in length) OR a main beam length of 10 inches or more, antlerless deer and wild hog. The bag limit shall be 1 antlered and 1 antlerless deer per FFS permit. No size or bag limit for wild hog.

**PERMITS**

An FFS permit shall be required to hunt the area. A maximum of 4 permits shall be issued by the FFS for this 4-day hunt.

**SPECIFIC AREA REGULATIONS**

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.062(17), F.A.C. the following regulations shall apply:

- 1) Only the FFS permit holder may harvest wildlife.
- 2) Only shotguns, rifles, pistols, bows or crossbows may be used to harvest wildlife.
- 3) Motorized vehicles may be operated only during the special general gun hunt and the day before the hunt and only on named or numbered roads, except that the FFS may authorize additional vehicle access as necessary.
- 4) All other provisions of Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.062 (17), F.A.C., shall remain in effect.
