This dataset shows the seagrass cover change for the Florida panhandle estuaries: Big Lagoon, Choctawhatchee Bay, Pensacola Bay, Perdido Bay, Santa Rosa Sound, Saint Andrew Bay, and Saint Joseph Bay. The cover change was completed using seagrass cover maps for 1950, 1992, 2002/2003, 2010/2011, 2015, and 2017.






Perdido Bay 1950 to 1992




Perdido Bay 1992 to 2002
