**Reduction of Spanish Mackerel East
Coast Region Commercial Vessel Limit**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Paragraph 22 of the Delegations of Authority, and due to the reduction of the federal Atlantic Spanish mackerel commercial vessel limit to 500 pounds effective January 27, 2019, in response to the 2018-2019 federal Spanish mackerel adjusted southern zone commercial quota having been met, hereby reduces the Spanish mackerel East Coast Region commercial vessel limit to 500 pounds per vessel per day through February 28, 2019. Such actions are only authorized as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in 68B-23, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the Spanish mackerel East Coast Region commercial vessel limit shall be 500 pounds per vessel per day effective 6:00 a.m., local time, January 27, 2019, through February 28, 2019.
2. All other rules or orders of the Commission relating to 68B-23, F.A.C, shall remain in effect.
3. This order shall expire at 12:00 a.m. on March 1, 2019.
