Executive Order Number: EO 19-10

**Blackwater Wildlife Management Area
Operation Outdoor Freedom Spring Turkey
Hunt**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and Rule 68A-15.004(16), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), hereby authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service (FFS) consistent with 589.19(4), Florida Statutes, on the closed to hunting portions of Blackwater Wildlife Management Area in Okaloosa and Santa Rosa counties, Florida.

OPEN SEASON

Special spring turkey hunt – March 27-29, 2019.

LEGAL TO TAKE

Gobblers or bearded turkeys only. The bag limit shall be two (2) gobblers or bearded turkey per FFS permit, but only one per day.

PERMITS

A FFS permit shall be required to hunt the area. A maximum of two (2) permits shall be issued by the FFS for this hunt.

SPECIFIC AREA REGULATIONS

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.063(4), F.A.C., the following regulations shall apply:

- 1) Only the FFS permit holder may harvest turkey.
- 2) Motorized vehicles may be operated only on named or numbered roads, except that the FFS may authorize additional vehicle access as necessary for accommodation purposes.
- 3) All other provisions of Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.063(4), F.A.C., shall remain in effect.

This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 pm on March 29, 2019.


