Dusky-headed Parakeet *Aratinga weddellii*

A sizable flock of Dusky-headed Parakeets, of Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, and Brazil, occurs in Miami Springs, and scattered smaller flocks are observed elsewhere in Dade County. The species has been observed breeding in old woodpecker holes in utility poles in several neighborhoods of Miami Springs.
