The Orange-fronted Parakeet is uncommon in Dade County. Long (1981) lists the Orange-fronted Parakeet as "possibly established successfully," but they are certainly not common at the present time. During the first year of the Atlas project, a pair was observed copulating in a Miami Springs neighborhood, but no nest was located.
