SUBJECT: General Gun – Vehicle Permit Recommendations for Holey Land, Rotenberger and Everglades and Francis S. Taylor Wildlife Management Areas – 2019-20

Attached is an order establishing the number of general gun - vehicle permits to be issued for Holey Land, Rotenberger and Everglades and Francis S. Taylor Wildlife Management Areas for the 2019-2020 hunting season.

The recommendation for Holey Land WMA is to issue the same number of tracked vehicle permits (29 permits) included in last year's Executive Order for the 2019-2020 hunting season.

The recommendation for Rotenberger WMA is to again issue no tracked vehicle permits (0 permits) for the 2019-2020 hunting season.

The recommendation for Everglades and Francis S. Taylor WMA is to issue the same number of tracked vehicle permits (35 permits) included in last year's Executive Order for the 2019-2020 hunting season and to reduce the number of airboat permits from 10 to 0.

These recommendations are based on deer population surveys and previous harvests. Please let us know if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss these proposals further.

Taylor Wildlife Management Areas for the 2019-20 hunting season as follows:

Holey Land WMA:

Tracked vehicles 29 (1 antlered deer tag each)

Rotenberger WMA:

Tracked vehicles 0

Everglades and Francis S Taylor WMA:

Conservation Area 3A North

Tracked vehicles 35 (1 antlered deer tag each)




