**Special Regulations for the Aucilla
Wildlife Management Area**


The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution and Rule 68A-14.001(2), F.A.C., hereby establishes, by order, special regulations for the Aucilla Wildlife Management Area. These special regulations are necessary due to a hunt schedule error causing an overlap between the opening weekend of archery season and the 3-day September wild hog-dog hunt. Allowing both hunts to occur at the same time will lead to user conflict. The special regulations are as follows:

1. The September wild hog-dog hunt scheduled to occur September 13-15, 2019 is hereby canceled and rescheduled 1 week earlier to occur September 6-8, 2019.
2. All provisions of Title 68A not in conflict with this order shall remain in effect.

This order shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m., September 16, 2019
