FWC EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19-30

HURRICANE DORIAN

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under 68-1.009, F.A.C., Delegations of Authority, February 14, 2013, Paragraphs 17 and 22, and pursuant to the Executive Office of the Governor, Executive Orders Nos. 19-189 and 19-190 (Emergency Management -Hurricane Dorian), hereby takes the actions specified below in response to the emergency conditions imposed by Hurricane Dorian.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted by Executive Orders 19-189 and 19-190 of the Executive Office of the Governor; and the aforementioned Delegations of Authority of the Commission:

1. I hereby suspend, to the extent necessary to ensure any emergency response functions, the effect of any statute, rule or order, to the extent needed to procure any and all necessary commodities or contractual services, temporary premises, and other resources to include, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any and all statutes, rules or orders which affect budgeting, leasing, printing, purchasing, travel, the condition of employment and the compensation of employees.
2. I hereby delegate to the Chief Operating Officer (COO) the authority to close Tallahassee area buildings and facilities to the extent necessary to meet this emergency.
3. I hereby delegate the Commission Regional Directors the authority to close such buildings and facilities and Commission managed lands/areas, in their respective portions of the state, to the extent necessary to meet this emergency.
 - a. I direct the COO and the Regional Directors to report the closure(s) of buildings and facilities to the Directors or designees of the Office of Human Resources, the Chief Operating Officer, the Office of Finance and Budget and the Office of Community Relations.
 - b. I further direct the Finance and Budget Director to coordinate and maintain an up-to-date list of all such closures; and to communicate the same to the Department of Management Services and the Office of Human Resources.
4. I hereby direct all Divisions and Offices to advise the Office of Finance and Budget of any expenditures related to this emergency within the appropriate timeframes established by the Office of Finance and Budget.
5. For the purposes of this Executive Order, "to the extent necessary" includes but is not limited to any emergency mitigation response or recovery action: (1) prescribed in the FWC Disaster Plan or Continuity of Operations Plan; or, (2) directed by the Emergency Coordinating Officer.

This Order shall be retroactive to Thursday August 29, 2019, the date of Office of the Governor Executive Orders Nos. 19-189 and 19-190. This order shall expire in sixty days unless Executive Order 19-190, or its predecessor, is extended, in which case this order shall so be extended.

Specific Authority: Executive Orders Nos. 19-189 and 19-190 of the Executive Office of the Governor, Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution and Rule 68-1.009, F.A.C.
