To receive your hunter safety certification card, you must submit the documents below to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission's Hunter Safety Section:

- 1) This application
- 2) A copy of a hunter safety course completion certificate from Florida Virtual School.
- 3) Proof of supervised live-firing of a firearm - see the back of this application for acceptable documentation.

Mail all of the above to the appropriate address listed on the back of this application.

I DO SWEAR OR AFFIRM THAT:

- a) In addition to successfully completing the Florida Virtual School approved hunter safety course, I have reviewed a copy of the current Florida Hunting Regulations, and that I am knowledgeable of the provisions contained therein.
- b) I pledge to follow the rules for safe hunting; respect the environment and wildlife; respect property and landowners; show consideration for non-hunters; hunt safely; know and obey the law; support wildlife and habitat conservation; pass on an ethical hunting tradition; strive to improve my outdoor skills and understanding of wildlife and hunt only with ethical hunters.
- c) I do not suffer from a physical infirmity that would prevent my safely handling a weapon or firearm.
- d) The information contained in this application and all attached documents is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

Acceptable Firearm Training Documents

- 1) Completion of any FWC approved Skill's Day. You can register for a Skill's Day – also known as an internet completion day – at MyFWC.com/HunterSafety. Upon completion of the hands-on training, have the instructor turn in this form with their final course report; or
- 2) Demonstrates proficiency by shooting a FWC Hunter Safety 50 ft. Light Rifle Target under the direct supervision of a range safety officer or a licensed hunter 21 years of age or older. (Targets can be found at MyFWC.com/HunterSafety.) The student must shoot a minimum of 20 rounds. It is preferred that the student shoots five rounds from four different shooting positions: Standing, Kneeling, Sitting, Prone or Benchrest. All shooting must be performed at an established shooting facility, following all safety rules and using appropriate eye and ear protection. The copy of the target must include your name and signature as well as the name, signature and contact telephone number of the supervising range safety officer or licensed hunter; or
- 3) Presents evidence of equivalent experience with a firearm through participation in an organized National Rifle Association shooting competition, 4-H Shooting Sports Training, Scholastic Clays Competition, ROTC firearms training, or military service; or
- 4) Completion of any National Rifle Association firearms training course where the live-firing of a firearm is a requirement for course completion; or
- 5) Completion of any firearms safety or training course or class available to the general public offered by law enforcement, junior college, college, private or public institution or organization or firearms training school, utilizing instructors certified by the National Rifle Association, Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission, or the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services where the live-firing of a firearm is a requirement for course completion; or
- 6) Completion of any law enforcement firearms safety or training course or class offered for security guards, investigators, special deputies, or any division or subdivision of law enforcement or security enforcement; or
- 7) Is licensed or has been licensed to carry a firearm in this state or a county or municipality of this state, unless such license has been revoked for cause;

If you are providing a copy of a training certificate/document, it must be clear and legible. The certificate/document must include your name, your instructor's, your instructor's qualifications/credentials (National Rifle Association instructor, 4-H shooting sports coach, ROTC instructor, law enforcement firearms instructor, Class "K" Firearm Instructor licensed by the State of Florida, etc.), and your instructor's license/certification number.

- NOTE: A photocopy of a certificate of completion of any of the courses or classes; or an affidavit from the instructor, school, club, organization, or group that conducted or taught said course or class attesting to the completion of the course or class by the applicant and that they witnessed the student safely live-firing a firearm; or a copy of any document which shows completion of the course or class or evidences participation in firearms competition shall constitute evidence of qualification under this paragraph.
