## **LEADERSHIP CAMP (CIT program) Application**

The Ocala Outdoor Adventure Camp (OCC) is starting a new program for high school students ages 15 to 17.

The Leadership Camp provides high school students with the responsibility to assist staff with camper activities. All Leadership Campers will receive training on programs we offer, how to interact with younger campers, and the various roles staff are required to fill for a residential camp.

The goal of the program is to prepare youth with leadership skills and for potential future staff positions at the camp. This program provides the participants an opportunity to experience a working environment in the field of outdoor recreation and conservation education.

Leadership campers will be assigned to do various work-related activities including assisting in the dining hall, and assisting in maintaining a clean and safe environment for campers. They will participate in the various camp activities that the campers are involved in.

40 Community Service hours are awarded for each week of volunteer service to the camp. There is a fee of \$150.00 for each week. High School students must apply to participate in the OCC Leadership Camp program.
