Executive Order Number: 20-03

**Operation Outdoor Freedom Deer Hunt on
Blackwater Wildlife Management Area**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and Rule 68A-15.004(16), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), hereby rescinds EO 20-02 and authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service (FFS) consistent with 589.19(4), Florida Statutes on the closed to hunting portions of Blackwater Wildlife Management Area in Okaloosa and Santa Rosa counties, Florida.

OPEN SEASON

Special deer hunt – February 18-21, 2020.

LEGAL TO TAKE

Any deer (except spotted fawns), wild hog and coyote. The bag limit shall be 2 antlered deer and 2 antlerless deer per FFS permit. There is no bag limit for wild hog or coyote.

PERMITS

An FFS permit shall be required to hunt the area. A maximum of four permits shall be issued by the FFS for this hunt.


SPECIFIC AREA REGULATIONS

In addition to the regulations contained in Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.063(4), F.A.C., the following regulations shall apply:

- 1) Only the FFS permit holder may harvest wildlife.
- 2) Only bows, crossbows or muzzleloading guns may be used for hunting.
- 3) Motorized vehicles may be operated only on named or numbered roads, except that the FFS may authorize additional vehicle access as necessary for accommodation purposes.

This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 pm on 21 February 2020.
