
## Harvest Unit Description

The state- and privately-owned waters and wetlands located within Dixie County that have public access or for which access has been granted for the purpose of harvesting alligators under this permit, including the Jena Unit of the Big Bend Wildlife Management Area (subject to area specific access restrictions), and including contiguous state-owned waters that cross the county boundary. This management unit does not include: all waters within the boundary of the Lower Suwannee National Wildlife Refuge west of the Suwannee River; within 400 feet of the mean-high or ordinary-high waterline or within 400 feet of emergent vegetation bordering state parks, preserves and reserves; and any private lands included in management programs governed by Rule 68A-25.032, F.A.C.

## Harvest Unit Description

The state- and privately-owned waters and wetlands located within Duval County that have public access or for which access has been granted for the purpose of harvesting alligators under this permit, including contiguous state-owned waters that cross the county boundary. This management unit does not include: any municipal recreation or preservation/conservation area including those owned or managed by the City of Jacksonville; Timucuan Ecological and Historic Preserve; within 400 feet of the mean-high or ordinary-high waterline or within 400 feet of emergent vegetation bordering state parks, preserves and reserves; and any private lands included in management programs governed by Rule 68A-25.032, F.A.C.
