


The state- and privately-owned waters and wetlands located within Leon County that have public access or for which access has been granted for the purpose of harvesting alligators under this permit, including the L. Kirk Edwards Wildlife and Environmental Area (subject to area specific access restrictions), and including contiguous state-owned waters that cross the county boundary. This management unit does not include: lakes Iamonia, Miccosukee, and Talquin; within 400 feet of the mean-high or ordinary-high waterline or within 400 feet of emergent vegetation bordering state parks, preserves and reserves and any private lands included in management programs governed by Rule 68A-25.032, F.A.C. 

This management unit does not include: all waters within the boundary of the Lower Suwannee National Wildlife Refuge east of the Suwannee River; Lake Rousseau; within 400 feet of the mean-high or ordinary-high waterline or within 400 feet of emergent vegetation bordering state parks, preserves and reserves; and any private lands included in management programs governed by Rule 68A-25.032, F.A.C.




