FWC ORDER NO. 20-20

Commercial Saltwater License Extension

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Paragraph 22 of the Delegations of Authority, and due to exigent circumstance as well as a back-log of commercial saltwater license applications hereby modifies the expiration date of the licenses identified below while the Commission works to process those applications received.

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the following specified licenses issued by the Commission are modified as identified in paragraph 2.
 - a. Commercial Saltwater Products license and any associated fishing endorsements;
 - b. Wholesale Saltwater Products Dealer license;
 - c. Retail Saltwater Products Dealer license;
 - d. Live Bait Shrimp Production license and Commercial Food Shrimp Production license; and,
 - e. Tampa Bay Food Shrimp Production license.

2. Licenses listed in paragraph 1 that were valid on June 30, 2020 are hereby extended until July 31, 2020.

This Order upon execution shall be retroactively effective to June 30, 2020 and shall expire on July 31, 2020 unless rescinded or extended by subsequent order.
