FWC Executive Order No. EO 20-21

**Special Regulations for the Florida  
Keys Wildlife and Environmental  
Area**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution hereby establishes, by order, special regulations for the Florida Keys Wildlife and Environmental Area (WEA) as indicated below. These regulations are necessary to ensure coordination and consistency with Monroe County and the Florida Park Service on beach and municipal and state park closures for the purposes of natural resource protection and public safety.

- (1) The following areas are closed to all public access:
  - a. Florida Keys WEA, including Sammy Creek Landing, Johnson Tract, and all other public access points
- (2) Any provisions of Title 68A, F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded.
- (3) This order shall take effect at 5:00 PM, July 2, 2020, and shall remain in effect until 8:00 AM, July 7, 2020, unless amended or rescinded by subsequent order.
