Translocations of Florida mice should not occur beyond the ridge system on which they were first captured. Florida mice should only be moved to areas of the same natural community (i.e., scrub or sandhill). Translocations across long distances (>10km) or potential barriers, such as mesic communities or rivers, should be avoided.




Figure 2. Florida mouse (*Peromyscus floridanus*) range with the Lake Wales Ridge geologic ridge system. Translocations of Florida mice should not occur across the North-South delineation. Mice captured north of the Polk-Highlands county line should remain in the northern section of the Lake Wales Ridge and mice captured south of the Polk-Highlands county line should remain in the southern section of the Lake Wales Ridge.
