




# Bat Origami




Fold paper in half touching corner to corner.



Fold top point of one flap down past the edge of the paper.




# Butterfly




Fold paper in half touching corner to corner. Unfold. Repeat with other corners.




Turn paper over and fold book-style. Unfold. Repeat book fold from top to bottom




Push in on all sides and squash to collapse into a triangle.




Turn triangle sideways. Fold corner as shown.




Spread open flaps.




Squash the bottom of the butterfly.

Make two cuts as deep as you can.






# Cicada Origami




Fold paper in half touching corner to corner.




Fold smaller corners up to the top of the triangle.

Fold the second flap down, but not as far as the first.



Fold the sides underneath on an angle.




Fold the whole cicada in half along the centerline.



This is the final cicada!


## Special: Flapping Clam

Start with a square cut in half.




Fold a sharp crease about halfway down and leave the other half loosely folded.

Pre-crease the corner as shown, then open up all folds.




Make sure the creases are well folded as shown.


Fold rectangle in half from top to bottom.




With the colored side up, pinch as shown and fold so that the diamond goes inward and the two halves of the shell begin to close. The paper will NOT lie flat.



Pinch along horizontal crease and fold to close the clam. The paper will NOT lie flat.






Fold the interior flap firmly to one side.



1) Fold paper in half. Fold in half again, crease, and unfold. Crease the top portion in quarters as shown. Unfold.



2). Fold top portion down while pushing down sides at arrows. Fold up loose corners to make a point.





3) Fold in both sides and fold down top edges over sides as shown. Fold top portion over half way down and fold under at the midline between body and tail.

4) Make your frog hop by setting it on a flat surface, pressing down on the back and releasing quickly.






2) Fold in bottom edges and then top edges over that.



5) Fold the tip of the head down and crease each section into a spring.




