
Order No. EO 10-06

Executive Order Prohibiting the Take of Foxes or
Coyotes by Dogs Within an Enclosed Area

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, hereby prohibits the use of a dog or dogs for the taking of fox or coyotes within an area of land fenced or enclosed in such a manner as to prevent any natural ingress or egress of such fox or coyotes. The prohibitions in this order include areas which were formerly permitted by the commission as a fox enclosure and areas documented by the commission as an area which has been used as a fox enclosure.


This order shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on February 25, 2010 and shall remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order or rule of the commission.
