**Order No. EO 10-47**

**Camp Blanding Wildlife Management Area**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution, hereby revises hunts scheduled during the 2010-2011 hunting season on the Camp Blanding Wildlife Management Area (WMA), described in 68A-15.062(1), as follows:

- (1) The archery-only areas (A-F), described in 68A-15.062(1)(a)(4) are open for hunting during two archery hunts scheduled for September 28-30 and October 5-7 and for two muzzleloading gun quota hunts scheduled for October 12-14 and October 19-21. These areas are being opened during these time periods in order to provide additional acreage to archery hunters and muzzleloading gun hunters who will not be able to utilize Still Hunt Area #1 during the normal scheduled hunts. Further, a portion of Still Hunt Area #2, north of Greble Road, will also be unavailable for the October 5-7 archery hunt, creating an additional need to open up additional acreage in the archery-only areas.
- (2) Archery-only areas A,B,C,D,E and F, which are scheduled to be open for archery hunting November 20-January 16, are rescheduled to be open November 22-January 16. This change results in the loss of a Saturday and Sunday in the beginning of the hunt.
- (3) The first two days of the general gun still hunt (Nov. 20-21) are eliminated from the 9-day quota period, thereby converting the usual 9-day quota period to a seven day quota period. This 7-day quota period is now comprised of a 4-day quota hunt (Nov. 22-25) followed by a 3-day quota hunt (Nov. 26-28) in both Still Hunt Areas #1 and #2.
- (4) The first general gun dog hunt quota period scheduled for November 20-28 is rescheduled to November 22-November 30.
- (5) The revisions to these seasons are necessitated because of conflict with military training that has been recently added to Camp Blanding's schedule to prepare troops for deployment.

This action is effective upon signing by the Executive Director.


