OF FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Order No. EO11-12

Special Regulations for Wildlife
Management Areas and Wildlife &
Environmental Areas and Other Lands
Managed By FWC Areas

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida,(FWC) acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby establishes, by order, special regulations for all Wildlife Management Area (WMA), Wildlife and Environmental Areas (WEA) and other lands managed by FWC areas. The State of Florida is experiencing inordinately dry conditions for this time of year. As a result, DOF and FWC have been fighting multiple wildfires within WMA, WEA and other lands managed by FWC. Therefore, special regulations are necessary to mitigate risk to public safety and to minimize the likelihood of igniting fires that will adversely impact wildlife and wildlife habitat. The special regulations are as follows:

- (1) Campfires are prohibited in WMA, WEA and all other lands managed by FWC.
- (2) Any provisions of Rules 68A-15 and 68A-17, F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.


This order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on 17th June 2011 and shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent order.


