Order No. EO 11-19

**Red Snapper Recreational Harvest
Closure in the Gulf of Mexico**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, hereby prohibits the recreational harvest of red snapper in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico beginning on July 19, 2011. This action is taken to have a state waters recreational red snapper harvest closure consistent with the federal waters harvest closure. This action is authorized only as follows:

1. Recreational harvest of red snapper in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico is closed beginning July 19, 2011.
2. All other provisions governing harvest of red snapper in Florida remain in effect.
3. This order shall take effect upon execution, and shall expire at 12:01 a.m. EDT, July 26, 2011.
