

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9 of the Florida Constitution, and implementing Rule 68A-15.005(3), F.A.C., hereby establishes the number of antlerless deer permits to be issued on selected Wildlife Management Areas and Wildlife and Environmental Areas for designated periods of the 2011-12 hunting season as follows:
