**ORDER NO: EO 11-29**

**Special Regulations for the  
Water Conservation Area 3A North  
portion of the Everglades and Francis  
S. Taylor Wildlife Management Area**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby establishes, by order, special regulations for the Water Conservation Area 3A North portion of the Everglades and Francis S. Taylor Wildlife Management Area. These special regulations are necessary due to inordinately high water levels that have jeopardized wildlife, particularly deer, and that create a potential threat to public safety. The special regulations are as follows:

- (1) The taking of game as defined in section 68A-1.004, F.A.C. is prohibited except ducks and coot may be taken in accordance with 68A-13.003, snipe may be taken in accordance with 68A-13.008, and frogging is allowed in accordance with 68A-15.004.
- (2) Vehicles, airboats, and other public access are prohibited.
- (3) This order shall not apply to persons permitted to participate in the statewide migratory bird hunts, frogging, or persons operating boats (other than airboats) within the established canal system and within 1 mile of adjacent marshes.
- (4) Persons participating in the statewide migratory bird hunts and frogging shall use vessels only for access and shall maintain a minimum distance of 100 yards from any tree island or surrounding levee to minimize disturbance to terrestrial wildlife jeopardized by high water conditions.
- (5) Any provisions of Rule 68A-15.064, F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on 14 November 2011 and shall remain in effect until rescinded by subsequent order.
