OF FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Order No. EO 11-14

Public Waters Alligator Egg Permit Fee

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida (FWC), acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby reduces the egg permit fee as referenced in Rule 68A-25.031, F.A.C. for the 2011 public waters egg collection season. The Governor, under his veto authority, eliminated the FWC's budget appropriation to transfer \$1 of the \$5 egg permit fee to fund alligator marketing and education activities. Since the current egg permit fee established in Rule 68A-25.031, F.A.C., still incorporates a \$1 contribution towards alligator marketing and education activities, it is necessary to reduce the egg permit fee so that public waters egg collection program participants are not charged more than is appropriate under these circumstances.

- (1) The fee for each egg permit purchased pursuant to Rule 68A-25.031(2)b.2., F.A.C., shall be reduced from \$5 to \$4

This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on 31 August 2011.
