**Special Regulations for the
Everglades and Francis S. Taylor
Wildlife Management Area**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby establishes, by order, special regulations for the Everglades and Francis S. Taylor Wildlife Management Area (WMA). These special regulations are necessary due to inordinately high water levels associated with recent storm events that have jeopardized wildlife, particularly deer. The special regulations are as follows:

1. The taking of game as defined in section 68A-1.004; F.A.C. is prohibited in the Everglades and Francis S. Taylor WMA.

2. Any provisions of Rule 68A-15.064, F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on the 5th of November, 2011 and shall remain in effect through the remainder of the 2011 General Gun Vehicle season (6th of November 2011 at 11:59 p.m.)
