Order No. EO 12-20

Bay County Oyster Harvesting Restrictions

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, hereby changes the allowable harvest limit for feral oysters in Bay County. This action is authorized only as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in 68B-27.014(1)(a), F.A.C., commercial harvest limits for feral oysters harvested from waters in Bay County will be 10 sixty-pound bags per person or vessel, whichever is less, per day.
2. All other rules of the Commission relating to oysters shall remain in effect.
3. This order shall take effect October 1st, 2012 and shall expire November 1, 2012.


