

**Operation Outdoor Freedom Spring
Turkey Hunt on Jennings Forest WMA**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution and Rule 68A-15.004(16), F.A.C, hereby authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service on Jennings Forest WMA consistent with 589.19, Florida Statutes.

OPEN SEASON:

Spring turkey special hunt: April 3-4, 2013.

LEGAL TO TAKE:

Gobbler or bearded turkey only. The bag limit shall be one gobbler or bearded turkey per permit. The take of turkey is allowed on those Jennings Forest WMA lands that lie inside Duval County only (see enclosed map).

PERMITS:

A Florida Forest Service permit shall be required to hunt the area consistent with 589.19, Florida Statutes. A maximum of three (3) permits shall be issued by the Florida Forest Service for this hunt.

SPECIFIC AREA REGULATIONS:


In addition to the regulations contained in Rule 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.062(18), F.A.C. the following regulations shall apply:

1. Participants are not required to check in and out at a check station when entering or exiting the area and are not required to report all game taken.
2. Only the Florida Forest Service permit holder may harvest a wild turkey. Each Florida Forest Service permit holder may be accompanied by one assistant who, with required licenses and permits for taking wild turkeys, may participate in the hunt but may not harvest wildlife.
3. Participants may use all-terrain vehicles and horses throughout the area during the spring turkey special hunt and the day before the hunt as necessary for accommodation purposes.
4. Any provisions of Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.062(18), F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.


This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on 4 April 2013.
