**Hunting Regulations for Migratory Birds
Other than Ducks and Coots**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution, hereby alters the possession limit for migratory game birds to three times the daily bag limit as specified in Rules 68A-13.008, F.A.C., as follows to conform with 50 CFR Part 20, Migratory Bird Hunting; Final Frameworks for Early-Season Migratory Bird Hunting Regulations; Final Rule, published in the Federal Register published in the Federal Register Vol. 78, No. 164 pages 52658- 52677 on August 23, 2013:

Notwithstanding the provisions of Rule 68A-13.008, F.A.C., the possession limit for mourning doves and white-winged doves shall be 45, singly or in the aggregate; the possession limit for Clapper and King rails shall be 45, singly or in the aggregate; the possession limit for Virginia and Sora rails shall be 75, singly or in the aggregate; the possession limit for Common moorhens shall be 45; the possession limit for Woodcock shall be 9; the possession limit for Snipe shall be 24; and the possession limit for migratory birds taken by the use of a falcon during the Falconry open seasons shall be 3 days' bag.
