**Rescinded: Delayed Opening of the Season for
Commercial Oyster Harvest for Apalachicola Bay**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, hereby rescinds the order closing the commercial harvest of oysters beginning September 1, 2013 in Apalachicola Bay, Franklin County, Florida, effective September 4th, 2013.

1. This order hereby rescinds order EO 13-32, Delayed Opening of the Season for Commercial Oyster Harvest for Apalachicola Bay.
2. This order shall become effective September 4th, 2013.
