Order No. EO 13-40

Special Regulations for the
Everglades and Francis S. Taylor, Holey Land, and
Rotenberger Wildlife Management Areas

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby rescinds order 13-21 and establishes, by order, special regulations for the Everglades and Francis S. Taylor, Holey Land, and Rotenberger Wildlife Management Areas. These special regulations are necessary due to extended period of inordinately high water levels associated with recent storm events that have jeopardized wildlife. The special regulations are as follows:

- (1) The taking of game as defined in section 68A-1.004, F.A.C. is prohibited except ducks and coot may be taken in accordance with 68A-13.003, snipe may be taken in accordance with 68A-13.008, and frogging is allowed in accordance with 68A-15.004.
- (2) The remainder of the General Gun-walk Season ending 20 October 2013 and the General Gun-vehicle Season from 26 October to 10 November 2013 are hereby cancelled.
- (3) Any provisions of Rule 68A-15.064, F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on 18 October 2013.
