Special Regulations for the Big Cypress
Wildlife Management Area

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegation of Authority Paragraph 22, hereby amends the 2013-14 hunting seasons, by order, for the Big Cypress Wildlife Management Area (WMA). These amended hunting seasons are necessary to offset a loss of 11 hunt days (6 days of archery season and 5 days of muzzleloading gun season) due to a federal shutdown which mandated the area be closed to public access from October 1-16. The special regulations are as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.064(5), F.A.C. the open seasons for Big Cypress WMA shall include the following:
 - a. Archery - October 31 through November 5, 2013 in all units.
 - b. Muzzleloading gun - November 6-10, 2013, except in the Deep Lake Unit.
2. Any provisions of Rules 68A-15.064(5), F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect upon execution.
