

Order Number: EO 14-08

**Spring Turkey Special Hunt on Lake George  
Wildlife Management Area – Dexter/Mary  
Farms Unit**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution and Rule 68A-15.004(16), Florida Administrative Code (FAC), hereby authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service consistent with 589.19(4), Florida Statutes on Lake George Wildlife Management Area – Dexter/Mary Farms Unit, consisting of 14,377 acres in Volusia County, Florida.

**OPEN SEASON:**

Spring turkey special hunts: March 15-21, March 29 through April 4, and April 12-18, 2014

**LEGAL TO TAKE**

Gobbler or bearded turkey only. The bag limit shall be one gobbler or bearded turkey per permit.

**PERMITS**

A Florida Forest Service permit shall be required for these hunts. A maximum of two (2) permits shall be issued by the Florida Forest Service for each hunt (six total permits).

**SPECIFIC REGULATIONS:**

In addition to the regulations contained in Rule 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.065(17), FAC, the following regulations shall apply to this area:

1. Only the Florida Forest Service permit holder may harvest a wild turkey.
2. The Florida Forest Service permit holder is not restricted to hunting in a specific zone, but shall coordinate with the check station staff each morning on which zone they intend to hunt.
3. One day prior to, one day after and during the spring turkey special hunts, public access and camping is allowed by individuals with valid Florida Forest Service permits and their assistants.
4. Florida Forest Service permit holders and their assistants may use all-terrain vehicles throughout the area one day prior to, one day after and during the spring turkey special hunts.
5. Motor vehicle access rules shall not apply to Florida Forest Service permit holders and their assistants one day prior to, one day after and during the spring turkey special hunts.

6. Any provisions of Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.065(17), FAC., which are inconsistent herein, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on 19 April 2014.
