**Order No. EO 15-06
State Waters**

**Recreational Harvest Closure of Gray Triggerfish in
the Gulf of Mexico**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, and due to the reduction in the federal recreational annual catch target and annual catch limit for gray triggerfish and the closure of federal waters of the Gulf of Mexico effective February 7, 2015, hereby closes the recreational season for gray triggerfish in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico. This closure is consistent with the closure in federal waters of the Gulf of Mexico by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Marine Fisheries Service.

1. The recreational season of gray triggerfish in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico shall close effective 12:01 A.M. local time on February 7, 2015 and remain closed through December 31, 2015. All recreational harvest of gray triggerfish shall be prohibited in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico during this time.
2. All other requirements of 68B-14, F.A.C., shall remain in effect during the closure.
3. This order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on February 7, 2015.


