**Recreational Harvest Closure of Greater Amberjack in State
Waters of the Gulf of Mexico**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, and due to the closure of federal waters of the Gulf of Mexico effective September 28, 2015, hereby closes the recreational season for greater amberjack in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico. This closure is consistent with the current closure in federal waters of the Gulf of Mexico by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Marine Fisheries Service.


1. The recreational season of greater amberjack in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico shall close effective 12:01 A.M. local time on November 21, 2015, and remain closed through December 31, 2015. All recreational harvest of greater amberjack shall be prohibited in state waters of the Gulf of Mexico during this time.
2. All other requirements of 68B-14, F.A.C., shall remain in effect during the closure.
3. This order shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on November 21, 2015.


