Order No. EO-16-36

Emergency Management – Hurricane Matthew

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and acting through its Executive Director under Delegations of Authority, February 14, 2013, pursuant to Paragraph 17 and Paragraph 22, and pursuant to the Executive Office of the Governor, Executive Order Number 16-230 (Emergency Management – Hurricane Matthew), Section 4(B), hereby takes the actions specified below in response to the emergency conditions imposed by Hurricane Matthew.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 4(B), Executive Order 16-230 of the Executive Office of the Governor; and the aforementioned Delegations of Authority of the Commission:

1. I hereby suspend, to the extent necessary to ensure any emergency response functions, the effect of any statute, rule, or order, to the extent needed to procure any and all necessary supplies, commodities, services, temporary premises, and other resources, to include, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any and all statutes, rules and orders which affect budgeting, leasing, printing, purchasing, travel, the conditions of employment and the compensation of employees.
2. I hereby authorize all Divisions and Offices responsible for the use of buildings and facilities to close such buildings and facilities in those portions of the state affected by the emergency, to the extent necessary to meet this emergency.
 - a. I direct all Divisions and Offices to report the closure of buildings and facilities to the Office of Human Resources.
 - b. I further direct the Office of Human Resources to coordinate and maintain an accurate and up-to-date list of all such closures; and to communicate the same to the Department of Management Services.
3. I hereby direct all Divisions and Offices to advise the Finance and Budget Office of any expenditures related to this emergency within the appropriate timeframes, as established by the Finance and Budget Office.
4. For the purposes of this Executive Order, “necessary action in coping with the emergency” means any emergency mitigation response, or recovery action: (1) prescribed in the FWC Disaster Plan or Continuity of Operations Plan; or, (2) directed by the Emergency Coordinating Officer.

This Order shall be retroactive to October 3, 2016, the date of Executive Order No. 16-230. This Order shall expire on November 2, 2016, unless extended (in increments of no more than thirty days) by the Commission under authority of Executive Order 16-230.
