FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

EO: 16-42

Rescinds Emergency Closure of Wildlife Management Areas, Fish Management Areas, Public Use Areas and Wildlife and Environmental Areas in the Sumter County section of the Green Swamp Wildlife Management Area.

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, acting under the authority of Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, hereby rescinds a portion of Executive Order:16-37, which created emergency closures on the Green Swamp Wildlife Management Area in Sumter County. Closure orders for these areas are hereby rescinded and all of these areas are re-opened for public access per current schedules effective 8:00 PM Friday October 7th, 2016.
