

Executive Order Number: 18-13

**OKALOACOOCHEE SLOUGH WILDLIFE
MANAGEMENT AREA OPERATION
OUTDOOR FREEDOM SPRING TURKEY
HUNT**

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, of the Florida Constitution, and Rule 68A-15.004(16), F.A.C, hereby authorizes the following special outdoor recreational opportunity to be administered by the Florida Forest Service (FFS) consistent with 589.19(4), Florida Statutes on the Okaloacoochee Slough Wildlife Management Area in Hendry and Collier counties, Florida.

OPEN SEASON

Special spring turkey hunt – March 23-25, 2018.

LEGAL TO TAKE

Gobblers or bearded turkeys only. The bag limit shall be one gobbler or bearded turkey per Florida Forest Service permit.

PERMITS

A Florida Forest Service permit shall be required to hunt the area. A maximum of six (6) permits shall be issued by the Florida Forest Service for this hunt.


SPECIFIC AREA REGULATIONS

In addition to the regulations contained in Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.064(6), F.A.C. the following regulations shall apply:

- 1) Only the Florida Forest Service permit holder may harvest wildlife.
- 2) Motorized vehicles may be operated only on named or numbered roads, except that the Florida Forest Service may authorize additional vehicle access as necessary for accommodation purposes.
- 3) Any provisions of Rules 68A-15.004 and 68A-15.064(6), F.A.C., which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby superseded.

This order shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in effect until 11:59 pm on 25 March 2018.
